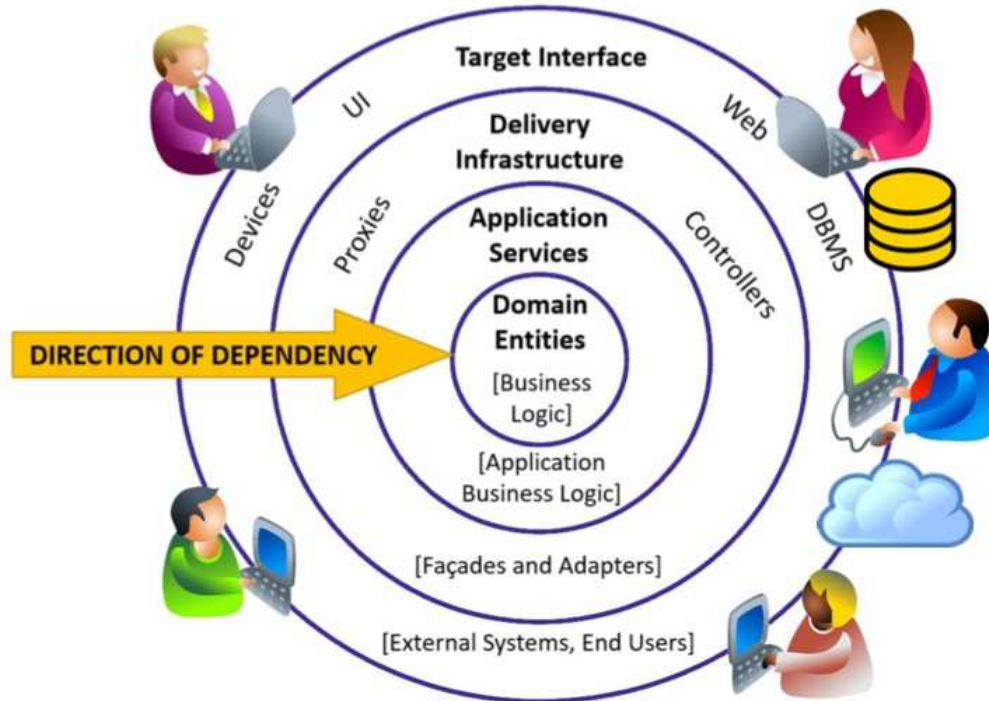

- Must be implemented in existing product

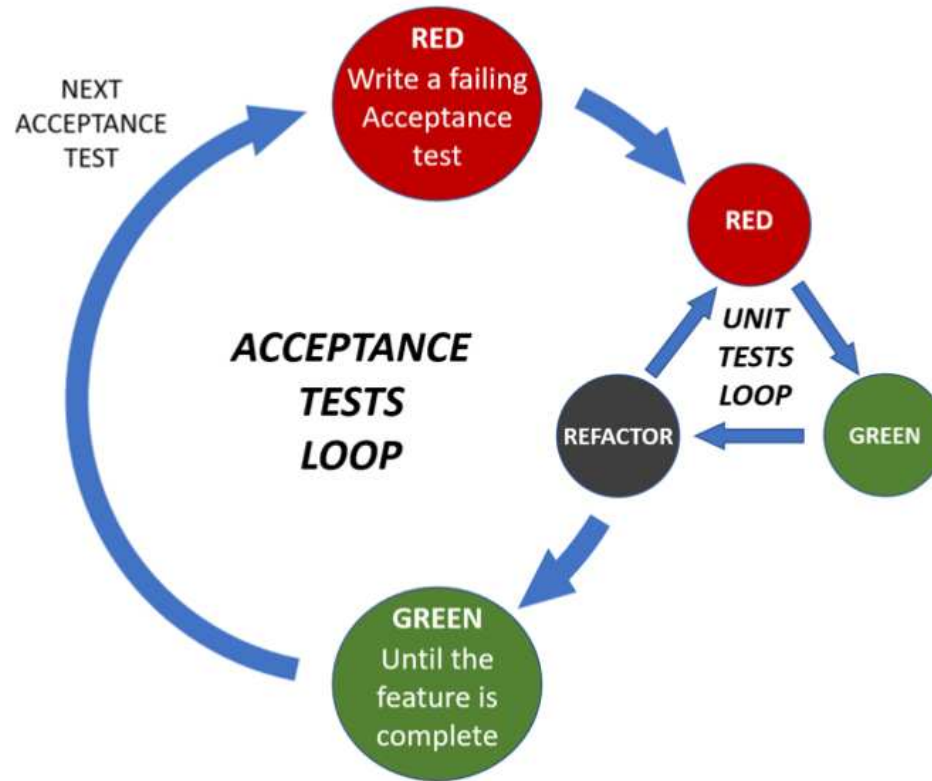
Was it implemented outside-in?

- Logic is divided in several classes
- The tests are not really «outside»

How to make it better

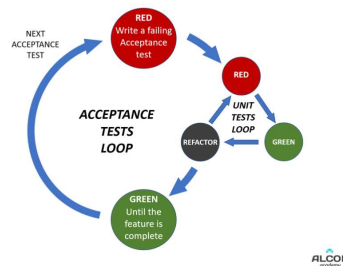
- Real/ Readable acceptance tests
- Don't use test doubles on our own classes
- Don't be scared of changing the workflow
- Speak with business people

My Learnings



My Learnings

- Writing acceptance tests together with business people
- Take the time before to make a clear architecture picture
- DO NOT write code, that is not used (also as a team)
- Ask business people, when you're not 100% sure
- Don't do that alone
