Simple Design


"Perfection is achieved, not when there is nothing more to add, but when there is nothing left to take away."

Passes All Tests


makes sure that the application works
pushes the design towards simple things
fast feedback



Reveals Intention

"Programs are meant to be read by humans and only incidentally for computers to execute."

- Donald Knuth



No Duplication

"Everything should be said once and only once."

- Kent Beck

this is more about duplication of knowledge, not code duplication



Fewest Element


remove everything that doesn't serve the first three rules

don't add elements to an architecture to increase its flexibility for future requirements.



Passes All Tests - how to

Outside-In TDD



Reveals Intention - how to

review after done writing

choose good names

keep everything small


challenge yourself

No Duplication - how to

rule of three

Don't Repeat Yourself (DRY) principle

one change in the requirement should only affect one place in the code



Fewest Element - how to


don't comment out code

delete unnecessary code

don't over-extract
